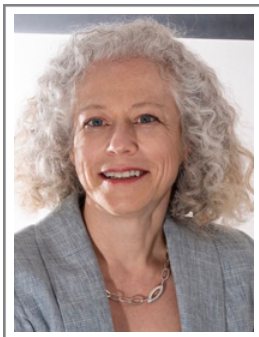
How Is Dementia Diagnosed?

- Reviewing medical and family history
- Physical exam
- Cognitive and neuropsychological tests
- Brain scans
- Laboratory tests
